Brett Borski KD8NAZ is an active young ham, especially when it comes to working 20 meters. He has been at the K8DAR station numerous times in the past several weeks, and usually manages to coax any number of stations to answer his CQ calls. Last Tues, Oct. 30, he sat down in the operator's chair in front of the Kenwood TS570 and proceeded to set a new record for

consecutive contacts at one sitting. 61 contacts were the result of his efforts on 20 meters. He has a magnetic communications skill that seems to draw stations to him, and he handles each contact very well. He can also log very well, but to make it easier for him, most of the logging was done by Ed KG8CX, when he wasn't busy attending to other DAR youth who wanted to work the echolink station.

Brett has over 200 contacts logged since early October. If he keeps up his current pace, the post office will need to hire a special truck to bring him all the QSL cards that have resulted. He is very competitive and will likely surpass his own record soon. We need people like him for the Wisconsin and Michigan QSO parties coming up in 2013.

Brett is a 15 year old General class and a 10th grader at Menominee High School. He was licensed in 2009 at the age of 12 through the DAR ham radio program. His brother Blake KD8ODP is an 8th grader and was licensed as a Technician in 2010.
