AMATEUR RADIO PARITY ACT ON FAST TRACK...

From the ARRL:

Just 10 days after being introduced, the 2017 Amateur Radio Parity Act legislation, H.R. 555, passed the U.S. House of Representatives. The bill's language is identical to that of the 2015 measure, H.R. 1301, which won House approval late last summer but failed to clear the U.S. Senate last fall.

H.R. 555 calls on the FCC to establish rules prohibiting the application of deed restrictions that preclude Amateur Radio communications on their face or as applied. Deed restrictions would have to impose the minimum practicable restriction on Amateur

Radio communications to accomplish the lawful purposes of homeowners association seeking to enforce the restriction.
