groups across the country set up portable stations to test our readiness to communicate under emergency conditions. It shows our ability to assemble stations from scratch in just a few hours. It's also a time for hams not familiar with HF operating to get a taste of it. It's a chance to show off our hobby to the public and government officials, and it's just a lot of fun.

As usual, we'll be operating from the Jones property west of 18^{th} Street at 32^{nd} Avenue. If you are not familiar with the location, check the map on W8PIF.COM.

Setup begins Friday afternoon June 21st. You are encouraged to stop in and help.

The operating period is 1pm Saturday to 1pm Sunday. You are welcome to come out and do some operating. You can operate on the HF bands regardless of your license class as long as a control operator is on site.
